

Subclass 600 – Visitor Visa Applicant Documents Checklist

Please provide the following **original** documents (**certified copies** of the originals are also acceptable, unless otherwise indicated), which will be used to support your application for a subclass 600 - Visitor visa under the Tourist stream. Please note that you will need to provide acceptable English translations for any documents that are not in English.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED	Applicant
IDENTITY & CHARACTER	
ONE recent passport-sized photograph (45mm x 35mm, head and shoulders only against a plain background, facing the camera & taken during the last 12 months. The person's name must be printed on the back of the photograph.)	
Current passport(s) (certified copies must include the identity details page AND all pages showing visas and stamps)	
Birth certificate (or family register) showing full birth details, including parents' names	
<i>If your legal name has changed (e.g. through marriage, formal name change):</i> Evidence of the legal name change e.g. marriage certificate, name change deed	
<i>If served in the armed forces of any country:</i> Military service records or discharge papers	
INTENTION TO VISIT	
Detailed itinerary for your intended stay in Australia	
<i>If you are visiting family or friends in Australia:</i> Letter of invitation from your relative or friend in Australia	
Evidence that you have sufficient funds to cover your costs during your stay in Australia (please see FAQ section below for further details)	
Evidence that you have an incentive to return to your home country e.g. employment, ongoing studies and/or close relatives	
APPLICANTS UNDER 18	
<i>If you are under 18, and you are not travelling with one or both of your parents:</i> Statutory declaration from the parent(s) not accompanying you, consenting to your travel to Australia	
<i>If you are under 18, and you will not be staying with a parent, guardian or relative in Australia:</i> Statutory declaration completed by the person with whom you will stay in Australia	
NOTE: You MAY also need to undergo health examinations and/or obtain health insurance (Please see below for further details)	

WE CAN HELP YOU OBTAIN YOUR DOCUMENTS

Please let us know if you require assistance in obtaining any of these documents, including:

- **English translations of any documents that are not in English:** We can obtain quotes from translators accepted by the Department of Home Affairs (DOHA).
- **Health examinations:** If you are required to undergo a health examination, we can complete the relevant health declaration on your behalf, generate the referral form, and provide information about where to have your examination.
- **Health insurance:** If you are required to obtain health insurance, we can apply on your behalf for an insurance policy that satisfies the DOHA's requirements, or provide you with guidance on what policies meet these requirements, if needed.
- **Certified copies of documents:** We are able to make certified copies of your documents if you send us the originals. Alternatively, please refer to the 'Frequently Asked Questions' section of this document for further details on how to obtain certified copies.

WHERE TO SEND YOUR DOCUMENTS

Scanned copies should be sent by **email** to support@dojolegal.com.au **as soon as practicable**. As mentioned above, scanned copies are acceptable in the first instance; however you may need to send hard copies of some of your documents to us before we lodge your visa application.
